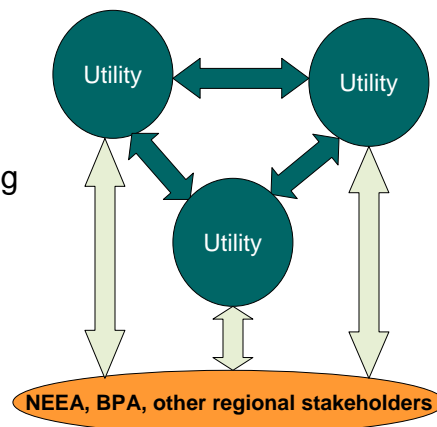

## Regional Online Community Functionality

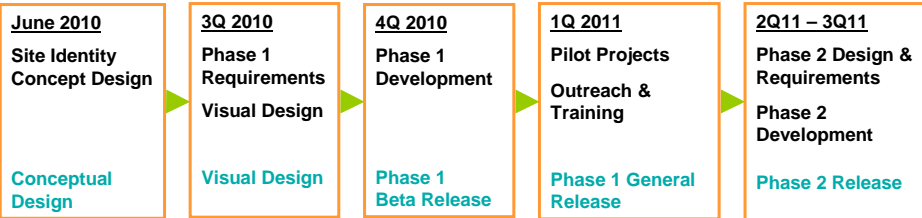
