- BiOp compliance (e.g., habitat restoration effectiveness, RRS, smolt transport, others).
- Tasks included tag insertion, tag detection/data management, interrogator construction and maintenance, and data analysis.

- QA of visual identification of run type (e.g., adult winter vs. summer steelhead).
- Primarily microsatellite and SNP methods.
- Tasks funded were sampling and analysis.

How Was The BPA Cost Data Derived?

- Taurus database queried in December, 2011 for projects in FY 11 and FY 12 with work element (WE) 158 (mark/tag animals) produced a list of 99 projects.
- It was known that the Taurus query would miss many projects with tag-related work (i.e., tagging was a milestone under a different WE, or the project was for tag recovery and/or analysis). Thus, to ID all projects with tagging-related costs, the project descriptions of all 406 active projects in Pisces in had to be skimmed, and the SOWs of all contracts read for those likely to have tag related tasks.
- If tag related tasks present, costs estimated from the "WE budget" tab, which often involved parsing the cost of a individual WEs.
- First done for FY 11 & 12 overall tagging costs. Redone later for FY 12 contracts only after all contracts issued, parsing by tag insertion, tag detection/retrieval/data management, and analysis.
